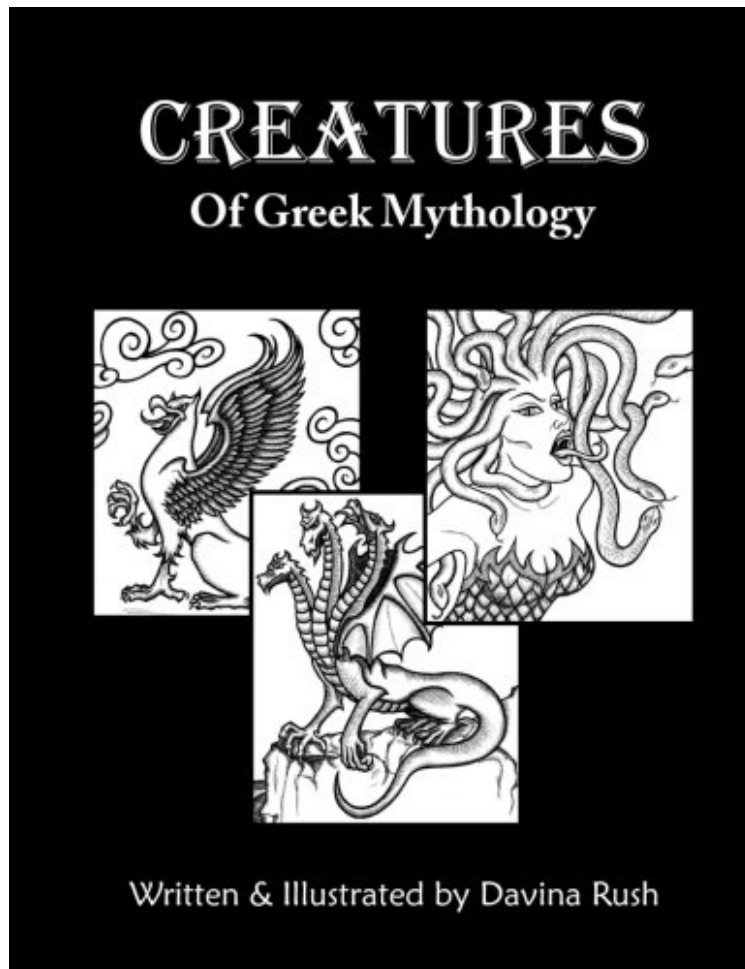

I started drawing each creature by hand and doing further collective research on each mythological deity. My children, ages 9 and 10 at the time, were anxious for each character to be finished so that I could run copies for them to color. Seeing their excitement and enjoyment in coloring my work was fuel for me to keep going with the project. Now, almost a year later, I still see the impact that my book has on them.
