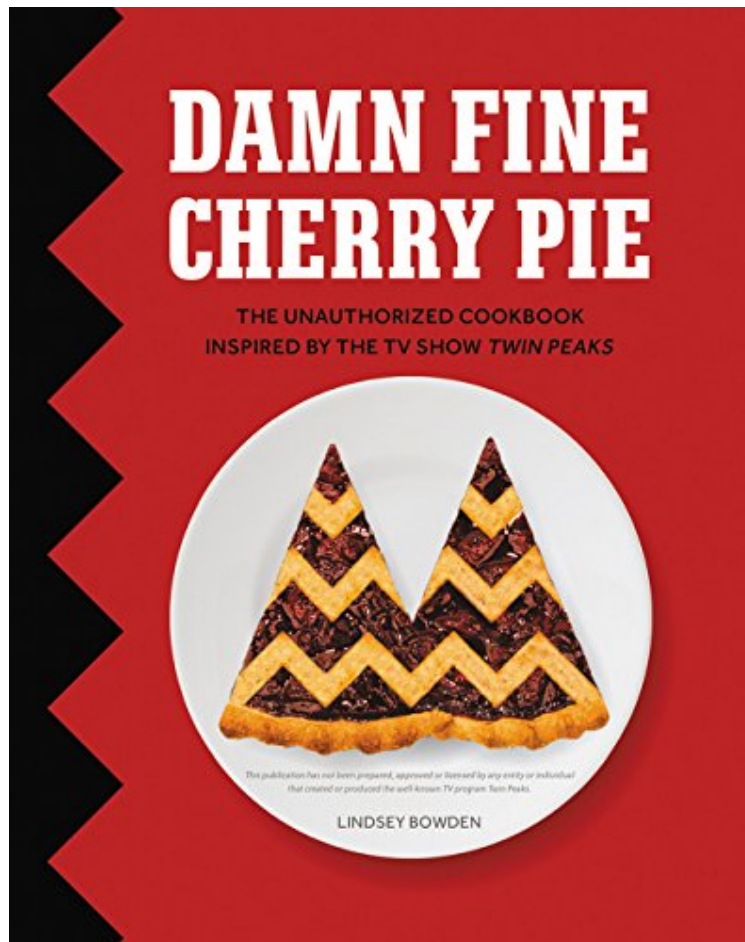

I give it four stars rather than five because the majority of recipes are impractical and it is unlikely that I would ever attempt to make them. The book doesn't quite hit the mark as an actual cookbook, but is a wonderful addition to the world of Twin Peaks-related items for fans. Works best as a guide to planning and outfitting a Twin Peaks-themed party. There are three contributions from actors (Kimmy Robertson (the best one!), Al Strobel, and Madchen Amick), but I wish there could have been a few more.
