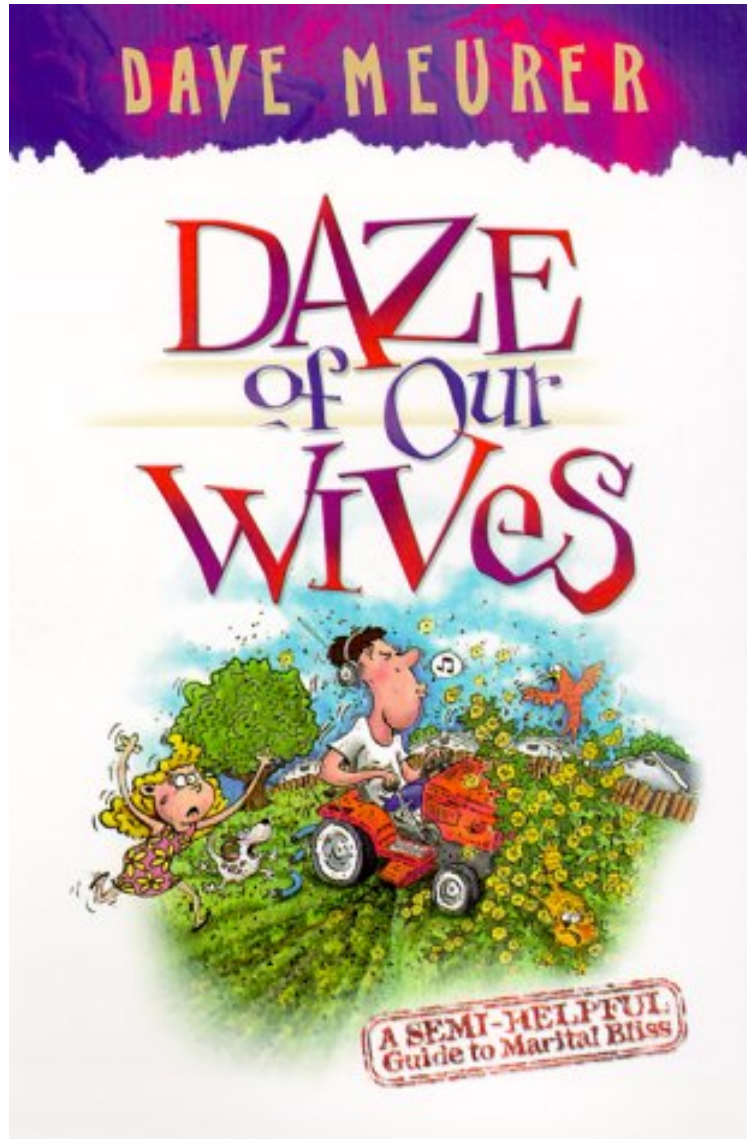

About the Author Dave Meurer is the father of two boys and was, according to rumor, once a boy himself. Raised as the third of his parents' five kids, Dave got an early taste of family. Now his childhood experiences and his time as the father of two teenage boys have been written in his outrageously funny book, *Boyhood Daze*. Less a parenting guide-- of which he feels there are too many-- than an industrial sized dose of laughter, *Boyhood Daze* is for all harried parents who need to know they are not alone as they tackle the enormous task of raising boys. When his is not engaged in dispensing sound parental advice (such as, "TURN THAT MUSIC DOWN!"), Dave works for the United States House of Representatives as an aide to a Californian Congressman.
