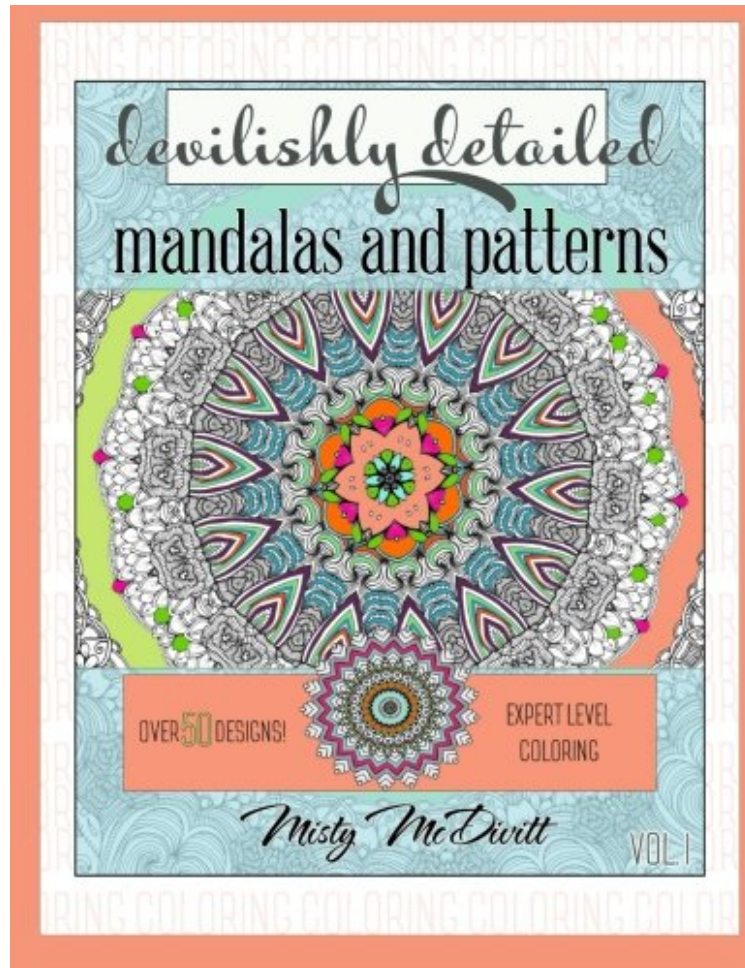

I'm really into ridiculously detailed designs to color, so I was looking forward to this book. However, the images in the book are so blurry that it is difficult to color with the detail I was hoping for. It almost looks as if the images were scanned at a high dpi, then printed at a much lower one--the lines are very pixelated and they are a mushy gray instead of crisp black. I'm sort of resigned to coloring books either having lines that are too heavy and black or too light and gray, but the designs in this book are so intricate I couldn't even go over them and sharpen things up with my smallest Sakura micron fineliner. To be fair, some images are of a reasonable sharpness, but most of the very detailed ones aren't. Also,

on a somewhat more superficial note--the cover of the book had a weird waxy coating on it that makes it very unpleasant to handle. Why no gloss finish? I'll still probably finish all the designs in the book, but it's going to be a lot more work and a lot less pleasurable than I was expecting. At least I'll get fineliner practice? Meh...
