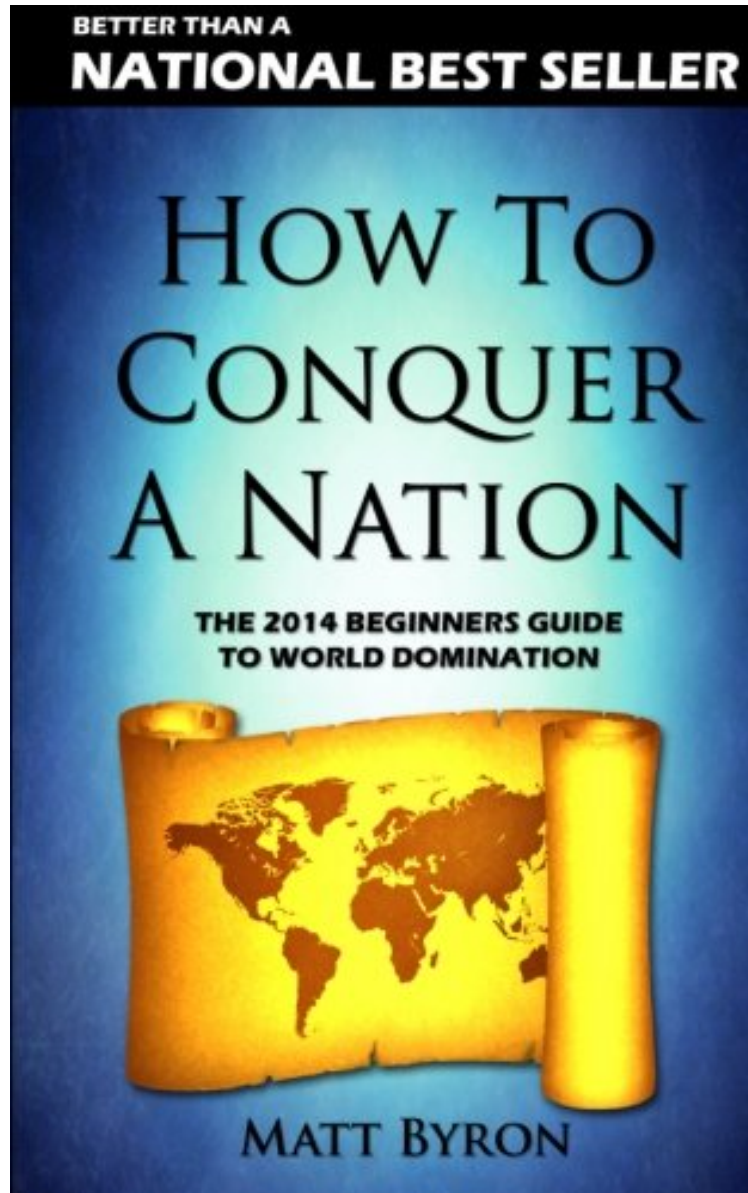

First of all, the "Better than a National Best Seller" is a rather cheap joke (at worst, a deceptive one), and it is sort of indicative of the humor inside. The author wants to be funny, but never quite rises above the type of commentary you'd hear at a dinner party. An example of the humor is the following: the author advises us to answer questions with questions. For example, to a question like "why are you raising taxes again?" we could answer "do you want to close schools?". I suppose some people could find that funny, but this style of humor seems quite common to me and not really deserving of an entire book--a book which is quite short, by the way. The author's optimistic price of 6.99 appears indicative of wishful indie-author thinking. I downloaded this for free, and I'd like to thank the author for the opportunity to read his work. He clearly put a lot of effort into this, and the cover is quite nice. To wrap up: maybe at a lower price you should take a chance on this author's honest effort if you are okay with humor that is not necessarily innovative.
