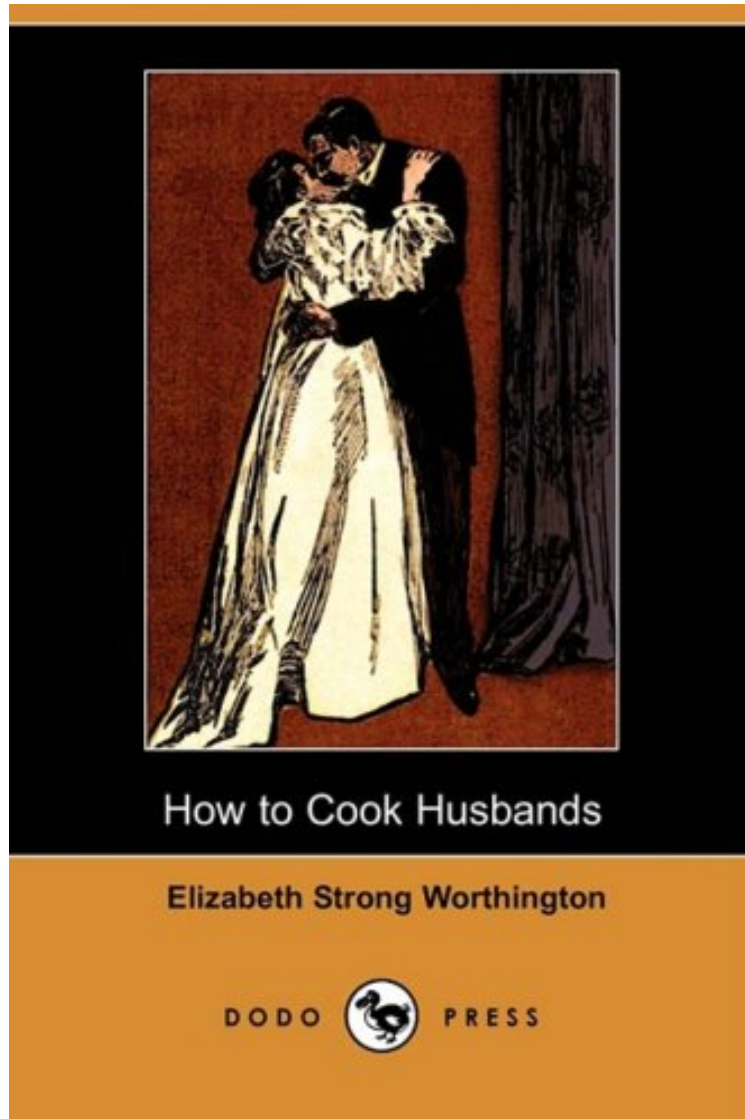

About the AuthorElizabeth Strong Worthington (October 5, 1851 - October 2, 1916) was a popular American writer during the latter part of the 19th century. Her first books *When Peggy Smiled: A Love Story* and *The Bidy Club*, were published in 1888. Her next works *The Little Brown Dog* and *How to Cook Husbands* (arguably her most popular work), came along in 1898, and her final book was *The Gentle Art of Cooking Wives* in 1900.
