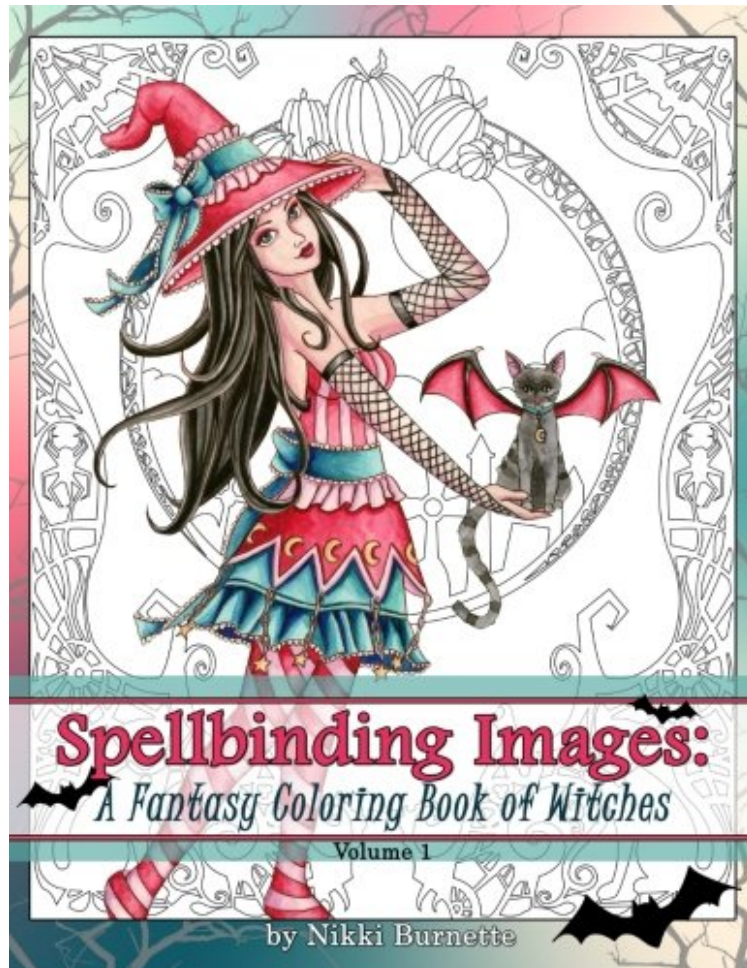

I really like this book and, I purchased 3 more of her books.. What I like most about these 20 witches are the quirky fun style of the pictures. There is one that I could imagine saying "really what am I doing here?" The expression given to each of the faces is done well rather than a "

frozen " expression. It is my opinion that this book would be appropriate for adults and teens. Some of the witches are posed and wearing outfits on the "sexy-side" my grandmother would say "skimpy". It is tame and tasteful one compared to some books I have seen available here. Features to this book: ~20 one-sided pages that vary from detailed to plain. This is nice if you don't have a lot of time to color. ~ The paper is thicker than average copier paper. My gel pens don't leave any bleed through or shadowing. My markers do bleed through. *I use a piece of cardboard from a calendar with piece of heavy weight construction paper taped to it. That way I can change the paper periodically and reuse the cardboard. ~ pictures size generally the designs go from top to bottom of the page. The background is simple in some picture. Drawbacks 1 the artist provides a frame to the pictures but they are symmetrical. The outside is thin while the top and bottom are thick. The far side runs into the binding . Although the design it's self doesn't. Book is non-perforated and doesn't like to stay open. If I can avoid it I don't like to break the spine. I am absolutely in love with the Spellbinding series and this book is yet again another beautiful addition. This book contains a lovely collection of fairies, mermaids, witches, and other girls of fantasy in a variety of settings with cute little friends and accessories to color as well. The book is of a skill level that you set. You can simply color the images as they are or add your own special creative touch to their sexy outfits and faces. I really like that the faces are drawn with nice, large features so adding a "made up" look isn't too difficult because you're battling eyes that are too small for eye makeup or cheeks that are too small to accent with some color. Nikki makes sure you have plenty of space in the eyelids and lips to add dramatic colors to make her girls look even more exotic. She's given you a template in which the possibilities are endless. These 20 lovely ladies are printed on one sided, non perforated paper that is of great quality in a glue binding. If you are going to use markers, gel pens, or perhaps watercolor pencils, I would put a piece or two of paper in between the pictures so that you don't accidentally have some bleed through onto the next pretty girl waiting for you to color her. Nikki has included one blank page in the back of the book that can be used for this purpose but if you are planning on using heavily inked markers I would add a few more just in case. I also found that once the binding is broken, you could easily cut out the picture if you wish without losing any of the drawing. Overall, I'm EXTREMELY happy with this book and would HIGHLY recommend it to anyone who likes fantasy coloring pictures that are not super difficult. Like I stated earlier, Nikki has left plenty of room for you to add your own creative touch or you can color them as they are and will still end up with a beautiful picture. I absolutely cannot wait for her next book in the Spellbinding series to come out, I hope there are many more to come from this very talented and creative artist!
