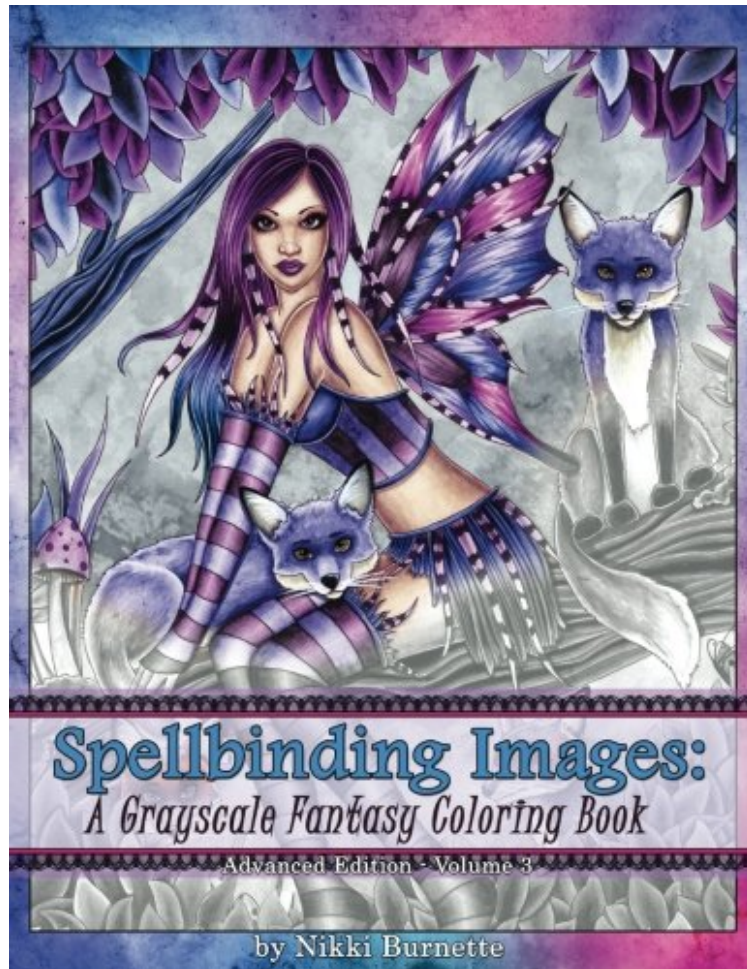

example, because it's what is shown in the picture (and yes I did mess up a little, but it's ok ^_^, everyone messes up sometimes!) You choose a light pink, medium pink, and darker pink. You colour the entire area you want pink with the light one, then the darker spots with the medium one, then the darkest spots with the darker one. And BAM! You have mastered greyscale. I much enjoy greyscale because it does give you the ability to take the guesswork out of shading, although with this trick, I have been shading non-greyscale lately, and I am totally enjoying it. I say you should buy from Selina Fench, Molly Harrison and Nikki Burnette, those are my favorites, but there are so many more that deserve respect as well, but I'm not sure if I should be name dropping... Just look into them, you'll love all their works, they're great for adults and children. About the photos. I was experimenting with colours, and when you use markers you should always put something behind the page or it will bleed through. But, I hope you enjoy this book as much as I am. I only showed the front picture because I want you two discover the greatness inside for yourself. But do remember with Nikki Burnette you get multiple prints of certain pages if you buy all her books, she has a few favorites that I am not fond of... But she also has a lot of really great work! :3 When I draw something, I don't like colouring it, but I love colouring other peoples work! :3
