There are a variety of styles, which makes

sense as the designs are all licensed from Shutterstock. I'm very happy to see the attribution on the "Look Inside" on . It lets you know immediately that the designs are curated rather than drawn by the editor of the book. For me, Mayo family has done a good job of curating these images as most are not familiar to me. The printing is well done, the editors put a framing line around each of the designs for a natural stopping point, and the designs are generally well fit to the page. Most of the designs are detailed and some are quite intricately drawn. For my first project in this coloring book, I chose to color a fairy playing tug-of-war with a bird. She is in a garden setting and they are tugging at a beautiful flower. I really enjoyed coloring this design using a variety of Sharpies and Bic Mark-it alcohol-based markers. This is what I found in this coloring book: 23 Fairy designs (licensed from Shutterstock) Page for checking colors, etc. Designs printed on one side of the page Paper is thin, white, slightly rough, non-perforated. Glue Bound Designs do not merge into the binding area Alcohol and water-based markers bleed through the page (I suggest you use a blotter page under your work.) Gel pens and India ink leave colorful shadows on the back of the page. Coloring pencils work well – good color, layer and blend well. Hard pencils dent the back of the page. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. Disappointed By Dog walker Really did not like this book very much, if you like to color faces this book will be for you as there is a lot, but the art work for the fairies is poor and reminds me of the Faerie Garden Spring book which I didn't like either. Far better books if you like to color fairies, would not purchase any more by Shawn Mayo.
